David Husband is a senior attorney with the Federal Reserve Board, focusing on privacy, cybersecurity, and national security. He has helped develop the Board's data breach, incident response, insider threat, and privacy programs/standards.

Prior to joining the Federal Reserve, he was the EPIC Appellate National Security Fellow, where he coauthored an amicus brief in the case of *Riley v. California*, which was cited twice by the Supreme Court in its unanimous opinion. He also serves as the Vice-Chair of the ABA Homeland Security Committee in the Science and Technology Section and is a member of the Information Technology Advisory Commission (ITAC) to Arlington County and serves on the County's Open Advisory Group.
